FAMILIES AND INDIVIDUALS

- Create a pinwheel garden for your home
- Decorate your home with lots of blue (lights, paintings, etc.)
- Post on social media about your prevention efforts
- Write a message using sidewalk chalk outside your home
- Paint your fingernails blue
- Draft a letter to your elected officials, emphasizing the need to invest in Idaho children and families
- Take some time for yourself
- Donate resources or volunteer your time to support Idaho children and families



BUSINESSES AND BUILDINGS

- Use blue lights to light up your space inside or outside
- Use the color blue to create a promotional offer to highlight Child Abuse Prevention
- Display pinwheel bouquets
- Post on social media about your prevention efforts
- Post a video sharing your preparations for Child Abuse Prevention Month
- Plan a virtual event with your social media community
- Host a Child Abuse Prevention window painting during the month of April

SCHOOLS AND ORGANIZATIONS

- Seek available funding to help with school and organization participation in Child Abuse Prevention month
- Raise awareness of Child Abuse Prevention in developmentally appropriate displays at your school or organization
